Special Regulations (Foreign EE-countries)
27th EE-European Show, 3rd European Junior Breeders Show for Rabbits and Cavies
December 7-9 2012 Neue Messe Fairgrounds, Leipzig

The EE regulations for EE-European Shows apply. The show management cannot be held responsible for the non-compliance on the exhibitor's part with these rules nor with incorrectly completed entry sheets. The exhibitor agrees to having his address and phone number published in the show catalogue.

1. The individual contact persons for each country have to send their national entries in by 15 September 2012 by regular mail to the following address: Oppressus – Post Box 1107 - 09306 Rochlitz/Germany. Entries by fax or email will not be accepted. Entries for the European Championship of Rabbit-Jumping will also be accepted under the above-mentioned address.

2. Entry fees (the entry fee includes a hand-over of 1 € per exhibit to the EE)

Rabbits: 12,00 €/exhibit

Cavies: 6,00 €/exhibit

3. Additional surcharge: 12,00 €/exhibitor

4. Catalogue: 10,00/exhibitor (mandatory)

The catalogue is optional only for junior exhibitors and officiating judges. Foreign exhibitors will receive their show catalogue in their respective national booth. **The entry fees for the show will be collected by your national contact person who will transfer the total amount to the show.** The processed copies of the entry form will only be mailed out after payment has been received in full.

5. Veterinary Regulations. All rabbits have to be vaccinated against RHD, a valid proof of which has to be presented upon check-in of the exhibits. Rabbits and cavies from restricted areas due to outbreaks of Fowl Plague, Newcastle Disease, Avian Cholera, Foot and Mouth Disease or Swine Fever must not participate in the show. The German veterinary regulations valid at the time of check-in apply. You will receive your veterinary regulations and pertaining documentation along with the processed copy of the entry forms.

6. With the copy of your processed entry form you will receive the tattoo registration form. Please complete this form with the animal's tattoo number that you actually check-in to the show. If you bring any different animals than the originally entered specimens, please report the sex and sales price via a modification form to the show. A fee of 2,50 € per modification applies. The modification form has to be handed in to the control staff of the show. The show cannot be held responsible for mistakes in filling in the tattoo registration card or failure to report modifications and its consequences.

7. Check in of exhibits is Tuesday, 4 December 2012 from 10 in the morning until 8 in the evening. You will be accompanied by control staff when checking in animals.

8. Sale of animals. The show management receives a handling commission of 15% of the listed sales price. A rebuy is not possible upon check-in of the animals. A rebuy possibility will be reinstated upon the beginning of the official sales hours. **Sales open on Friday, 7 December 2012 at 1 pm.**

9. Trophies and prizes for foreign exhibitors will be distributed via their respective national booth.

10. Animal loss due to force majeure or unanticipated events will not be compensated by the show management. The exhibits will be guarded for the duration of the show. Should a loss of an animal occur, please report this immediately to the Differences Department located in each pavilion. Damages will be paid out according to the valid rules. **Last possibility to report lost animals is Sunday, 9 December 2012 at 4 o'clock in the afternoon.**

11. Please bear in mind that from March 2011 on, the city of Leipzig has been declared an environmental protection zone. Car access to this zone is only possible if your car is furnished with the green environmental compliance plaque. **The Neue Messe and the roads leading up to the fairgrounds are not part of the environmental protection zone.**

12. Last possible day for filing complaints is 31 January 2013. Any claim has to be made in written form and sent to: Leipziger Rassegeflügelzüchtervereines 1869 e.V., Ritter-Pflugk-Str. 2, D-04249 Leipzig-Knauthain/Germany.

13. Court of jurisdiction is Leipzig.

Qualified entries:

- a) individual entries with poultry, pigeons, rabbit and caviés
- b) collections (4 entries of the same breed and colour) with poultry, pigeons, rabbits and caviés.

A collection has to have both sexes represented.

Only collections qualify for the title of "European Master". (Collections are 4 exhibits, both sexes)

EE-regulations for the titles of European Master and European Champion (abbreviated)

European Master: best collection (4 exhibits of the same breed and colour, mixed sexes, minimum result 376) in every breed with at least 20 exhibits, additional titles for every colour in the breed with at least 20 exhibits. In the case of a draw, all exhibitors will be granted the title "European Master". Collection Ornamental Fowl: 2 couples, same species, minimum result 188 points.

European champion: best exhibit in every breed with at least 20 exhibits, minimum result 95 points. Additional titles will be awarded for every colour in the same breed with at least 20 exhibits. Breeds/colours with more than 40 exhibits will be awarded a title for both cocks and hens. The international jury and the head-judges are in charge of awarding the titles.

EE-medals will be awarded for every 400 exhibits by the head-judges.
Every judge gets a European-pennant for awarding.
